- Production is overseen by celebrated winemaker Bruwer Raats (proprietor and winemaker of Raats Family Wines).

- A commitment to social responsibility is a key part of the Indaba philosophy, and a portion of the brand's sales supports a wine-related scholarship program administered in conjunction with Stellenbosch University.
- Indaba received a level 5 review (80%) from the Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment (BBBEE), which is an organization committed to motivate the correction of race and gender based inequalities that exist in South Africa as a legacy of the pre-1994 Apartheid rule.
